A man returns to his home territory & recalls traumatic events when he was seven, both at the hands of family as well as forces beyond this realm. Three generations of women, living at the end of the lane, beside a pond envisioned as an ocean, bridge the gap between the 2 worlds in ways only Gaiman can handle.

The memories of a child are poignantly drawn & the tale is brilliantly imaginative. Beautiful, lyrical writing, weaving the brutal & the gentle with great skill.
